

Updates to Students from VP for Enrollment Management

UMHB Students,

I hope that your Spring semester is progressing smoothly. We miss seeing you on campus, and look forward to your eventual return.

As a part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), UMHB students will be eligible to apply for an emergency relief grant to help with “their expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care and child-care expenses.” We are awaiting additional guidance from the Department of Education to be able to proceed with these grants. Once we receive this guidance, the Financial Aid Office will announce more specific details.

Please note that room and board refunds for residential students are separate and apart from the CARES emergency relief grants. No action is required to be considered for a room and board refund. The UMHB Bursar’s Office is currently working through the room and board refund process. We had previously communicated that we hoped to accomplish these by May 8, and we are on target to meet that goal.
